EXPECTATIONS FROM STATES IN ORGANISING D.EL.ED PROGRAMME

1. Register all untrained in-service teachers working at Elementary schools (Government/ Government aided/ Unaided Private Schools). **for D.El.Ed Programme at NIOS website www.nios.ac.in or <http://dled.nios.ac.in>**
2. All States and UTs to issue advertisements extensively (through Print and Electronic Mode) informing all teachers about admission norms, process and other activities.
3. All Block Education Officers be directed to issue the U-DISE number to schools who apply within 24 hours.
4. Identify adequate number of Study Centres as per NCTE Norms (100 Students per Study Centre)
5. State need to make preparation to conduct Personal Contact Programme (PCP) and Practical Activities such as School Based Activities (SBA), Workshop Based Activities (WBA) and Practice Teaching (PT), payment for which will be re-imbursed to the study centres directly.
6. Identify adequate number of Workshop Centres for Workshop Based Activities
7. Identify Resource Persons, Supervisors and Mentors (Working or Retired) from Teacher Education Institute (TEIs) for conducting PCP, evaluation of Tutor Marked Assignment (TMA), School Based Activities (SBA), Workshop Based Activities (WBA) and Practice Teaching (PT).
8. Conducting the orientation for Study Centres Coordinators, Resource Persons, Supervisors and Mentors (NIOS will help in organising in orientation).

9. Monitoring the activities of Study Centre coordinators/Workshop Coordinators, Resource Persons, Supervisors and Mentors. NIOS will also monitor independently.
10. Identify adequate number of Exam Centres for term end examination to be conducted by the NIOS.
